Just A Few Things SSC Is Working Towards.....

English Language (ELA): By June 2010, 75% of our students will attain proficiency in ELA reading comprehension as measured by the Literacy Benchmark Assessment.

Math: By June 2010, 88% of our students will attain proficiency in Math as measured by the Math Benchmark Assessment.

Parents Have Goals Too Parent & Community Involvement: By June 2010, a minimum of 80% of parents will participate in at least two (2) school events to support their child's learning including such activities as Parent Conferences, Family Literacy, Math and/or Science Nights, Family Fridays, ELAC, SSC or SGT meetings, Parent Trainings in core academics areas (20% parent attendance goal), documented by sign-in sheets and parent surveys.

Green's SSC's Budget & More!

Green's SSC has a budget of approximately \$27,000 that was 'defrosted' from the district wide frozen budgets. Now SSC will be able to continue to go forward with their SPSA education plan. Due to the student enrollment increase, the swim program saw an increase in costs as well but rest assured, the school recently got confirmation that the district was able to fund another year of swim for all students at Green Elementary!
